Faith to Take the Land (Jericho)

The Old Testament account of Israel's exodus from Egypt, wilderness wandering, and taking of the promised land is also an allegory for our lives:

...all our fathers were under the cloud, all passed through the sea, all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and the sea, all ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ... Now these things became our examples... all these things happened to them as examples and they were written for our admonition, upon whom the end of the ages has come. 1 Corinthians 10:1-11

The promises of the New Covenant:

Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant... Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the days when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt... For this is the covenant that I will make in those days: I will put My laws in their minds and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying, "Know the Lord," for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them. Hebrews 8:8-11
